Needle Disposal and Exchange

Place needles in a special sharps container

or an FDA-cleared household container

SAFE DISPOSAL OPTIONS

1. Drop-off Collection Sites

Take the filled container to an approved site:

- Health Departments
- Community Organizations
- Police and Fire Stations
- Medical Waste Facilities
- Physician's Offices
- Hospitals
- Health Clinics
- Pharmacies

2. Household Hazardous Waste Collection Sites

- Special container (similar to recycling container)
- Place outside/call for pickup or meet pick-up schedule of trained waste handling company

3. Mail Back Programs

- Patient mails sharps to a collection site
- Use special mailing containers approved by the U.S. Postal Service
- Protects patient privacy

4. Syringe Exchange Programs

- Patients exchange used needles for new ones
- Often operated by community organizations that handle proper disposal

5. Needle Destruction Devices (Home Use)

- Device clips, melts, or burns the needle, making it safe for household waste
- Syringe or plunger can then be disposed in household trash
