 - Comprehensive Opioid, Stimulant, Substance Abuse Program (COSSAP) grant in partnership with Michigan State Police

WHAT I WORKED ON

- OFR Evaluation
 - Analyze transcripts of interviews with members
 - Identify themes related to facilitators and barriers to participation, motivations, improvements, goals, etc.
 - Create a codebook and match data/quotes collected to major themes/quotes
- Findings
 - Increasing diversity and ease of access are essential to success
 - OFR is a unique, evidence-based approach
 - Participants have a variety of motivations to participate
 - Interdisciplinary and collaborative nature are biggest strengths
